The Franklin County Board of Education met at an adjusted time session at 4:30 p.m. Due to LMHS Graduation, at the Franklin County Schools' Riverside Campus. Quorum was met with the following members present: Vice Chair Mrs. Meghan Jordan, Dr. Elizabeth Keith, Mr. Chris Perry, Mr. Thomas Piper, Mrs. Paige Sayles, and Mrs. Debra Brodie. Chair Mrs. Rosemary Champion was absent. Superintendent Dr. Rhonda Schuhler and Attorney Boyd Sturges were present. Vice Chair Mrs. Meghan Jordan called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Dr. Elizabeth Keith, seconded by Mrs. Paige Sayles, and unanimously carried to approve the agenda with a modification to include an action Item to Amend the Budget for Capital Outlay.

A motion was made by Mrs. Paige Sayles, seconded by Mr. Chris Perry to approve the Student Fees schedule as presented with a slight modification to the Early College High School's Parking Regulations to state, not to supersede Vance Granville College regulations. The motion passed with a vote of five to one, Vice Chair Mrs. Meghan Jordan, Mrs. Debra Brodie, Mr. Chris Perry, Dr. Elizabeth Keith, and Mrs. Paige Sayles all voting in favor of the motion and Mr. Thomas Piper voting against the motion.

A motion was made by Dr. Elizabeth Keith, seconded by Mrs. Paige Sayles, and unanimously carried to approve the school-based mental health plan as presented.

A motion was made by Dr. Elizabeth Keith, seconded by Mr. Chris Perry, and unanimously carried to approve the Cleaning Contracts as presented.

A motion was made by Mrs. Paige Sayles, seconded by Mr. Thomas Piper, and unanimously carried to approve the Child Nutrition Vendors as presented.

Information items; Policies for Review, Parent's Guide to Student Achievement, and Plasma Games were shared with no action taking.

Superintendent Dr. Rhonda Schuhler gave a brief oral Superintendent's Report.
