Extended Content Standards (formerly Adapted Curriculum)

24/25 School Year

- **16 Classrooms**
- **16 Teaching Positions**
- **25 ECS Instructional Assistants**
- **5 Vacant Teaching Positions**
- **5 Vacant IA Positions**
- **Serving 126 Students**
 - **67 Elementary (68 capacity)**
 - **69 Secondary (72 capacity)**

25/26 School Year

- **17 Classrooms**
- **17 Teaching Positions**
- **27 ECS Instructional Assistants**
- **8 Vacant Teaching Positions**
- **8 Vacant IA Positions**
- **Serving Students**
 - **Elementary (78 capacity)**
 - **Secondary (74 capacity)**





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ECS Vacancies 25/26 (Current)

- 8 Teacher Vacancies
 - 4 vacant for 2 consecutive school years
- 8 IA Vacancies
- ECS Program Specialist will be needed to complete the required paperwork for these vacancies, if they are not staffed





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Proposal

- \$7000 Commitment to Teach for all ECS Teachers for 25/26 School Year; and \$3000 commitment to teach each year after (subject to board approval)
- \$1000 Commitment to work for all ECS Instructional Assistants
- Paid in August
- This is on top of the EC retention bonus
- Funding source: Federal carryover funds (will not increase current expense request)
