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### i-Ready Contract

#### 2022 - 23 District Quote: \$248,847.22

- i-Ready Reading is an intuitive supplemental tool used by students in grades 4th 8th
- i-Ready Math is an intuitive supplemental tool used by students in grades #8
- Diagnostics are given 3 times a year to establish learning pathways for each student.
- The i-Ready Teacher Toolkit provides standards aligned lessons that guide teacher instruction and intervention
- i-Ready is designed to support individualized learning (called pathways) that target specific skills students need support with (Goal: Complete 45 min each week and score 70% or higher on all lessons)
- Data from i-Ready informs instructional decisions and is a state recognized data source to identify students for summer learning interventions
- i-Ready is standards aligned and research based
- 2021-22 Impact Data Indicates Positive Results



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### Career Accelerator 2.0 Grant - PRC 188

Allotment: \$204,904.00

- The ESSER III Summer Programs grant application for PRC 188 has been approved.
- The total allotment received is \$204,904. Of that allotment, District C will receive \$150,000 to provide the Teamship experience.
- Remaining funds will be used for transportation costs, supplies, FCS staffing, and snacks/meals.
- The program will be available to a maximum of 120 FCS high school students including Early College.
- District C will plan and administer an intensive Teamship program that offers 30 internship hours to students.
- Students will solve real world problems for real businesses with coaching from the District C-certified coaches.
- This is our second time working with District C and we look forward to hosting this fun and rewarding experience for our high school students.
- The dates and times are: July 10- 13, 9 am 5 pm each day. The location is TBD. (Previously held at Louisburg College.)

Allotment: \$194,638.00

- Will Support 6th-8th Grade Math Intervention/Tutoring in 2022-23
- All 4 Middle Schools
- Retired & Certified Teachers to serve as tutors
- Primarily After School, but some during the day intervention
- i-Ready will be used to identify needs and monitor growth

Allotment: \$6,700.00

- Allotment represents about 25% of our application
- ESSER III (Expires 9/30/24)
- Application Approved (Partially Funded)
