

Summer Remediation Plan for Franklin County Schools

2022-2023 School Year

Purpose

The purpose of the Summer Remediation Program for Franklin County Schools is to provide students additional instruction in key areas where mastery of the standards was not attained. At the end of the program, students will be re-administered the North Carolina End-of-Grade or End-of-Course assessment to see if the student made gains in the areas identified prior to the remediation program.

Targeted Students

All students in grades 3-8 Math and Reading, Grade 5 and 8 Science, Biology, Math I, Math III, and English II who do not achieve a level III or higher on the state assessment will be afforded an opportunity to participate in a summer remediation program.

Program Structure/Timeline

Instructional Day: Remediation for students will take place at each school during two days in the window from June 12th through June 14th for regular Elementary, Middle, and regular High Schools. Youngsville Elementary will use June 9th through 13th and the Early College High School will use May 25th and May 26th as their remediation days. Each day will begin at 8:00am and will end at 1:00pm. If scores are delayed, schools will work with central office leadership to plan for other dates to provide remediation and to administer the assessment.

Transportation, Breakfast, and Lunch: Elementary, Middle, and High School students will be provided bus transportation along with breakfast and lunch each day.

Readministration

All students participating in the Summer Remediation program will be administered the assessment online unless otherwise stated in IEP or 504 plan that specifically requires the student to take the assessment paper/pencil.
