Blueprint Goal 1: Preparing FCS Students for College, Career and Life Beyond the Classroom

District C Summer Teamship

Franklin Summer Teamship is off to a great start. As you may recall from the February Superintendent's Report, we have 120 slots available for rising 8th-12th grade students to participate in the Franklin Summer Teamship that will take place at Louisburg College on July 10-13 from 9 am-5 pm. Registration opened on March 7 and of those 120 slots, 65 slots have been filled by students who have registered to attend. The District C team has commended Franklin County for our high number of registered students as compared to other districts across the state. The priority student registration deadline is April 14. Our goal is to recruit as many students as possible by the priority deadline. The final student registration deadline is May 26. We will explore additional recruitment options if we have not met our target number before the final deadline.

College and Career Ready Labs in Middle Schools

Paxton/Patterson College & Career Ready Labs have been ordered for three of our middle schools with future plans to purchase a lab for the fourth middle school next school year. We are using a CTE Modernization grant provided by the state as well as remaining CTE funds to support this initiative. Students will have the opportunity to explore careers by engaging in authentic problem-based learning experiences.
