FCS Electronic Records-An **Update** January 10, 2022

Student Records

- Beginning with the Class of 2017, all student records are collected and digitized. In 2022, the service provider will collect students records from graduating class of 2020 and 2021. Records were not collected in 2021 due to COVID-19. Student records remain at the school for one calendar year before being digitized.
- All Graduate Transcripts from 2014-2016 were provided to the company and scanned electronically, the cumulative records for these years are in storage. The goal is to have historical records from the high school digitally scanned one box at a time.

Other Electronic Records...

- All SIMS transcripts are digitized.
- All current high and closed school historical records have been stored.
- All closed school records that were located in the cafeteria at 53 West River Road are indexed. Indexed means that the name, date of birth, and box number they are in were compiled into a spreadsheet in order to locate records more easily if a record request comes through Need My Transcript.
- As records are digitized, they are placed back into storage. A microfilm backup of all records is created for the North Carolina state archives.
