Child's Internet Protection Act

April 2023



CIPA Compliance

- FCC requires all E-Rate recipients to be CIPA compliant.
- Schools and libraries may not receive E-Rate discounts if they fail to demonstrate that technology protection measures are in place.
- Protection measures must block or filter Internet access to pictures that are a.) obscene, b.) child pornography, or c.) harmful to minors.
- After a statewide audit, DPI found that some districts were not in compliance. Moving forward, DPI is asking each district to review their internet safety measures to ensure that all CIPA requirements are appropriately addressed. Once reviewed at a board meeting, the Director of Technology will provide documentation to DPI of district review of the policy.



FCS Board Policy: 3226/4205 Internet Safety

- Adopted by FCS Board of Education on October 13, 2014.
- After a review of policy recommendations from the NC School Boards Association, the policy is up-to-date and requires no changes.
