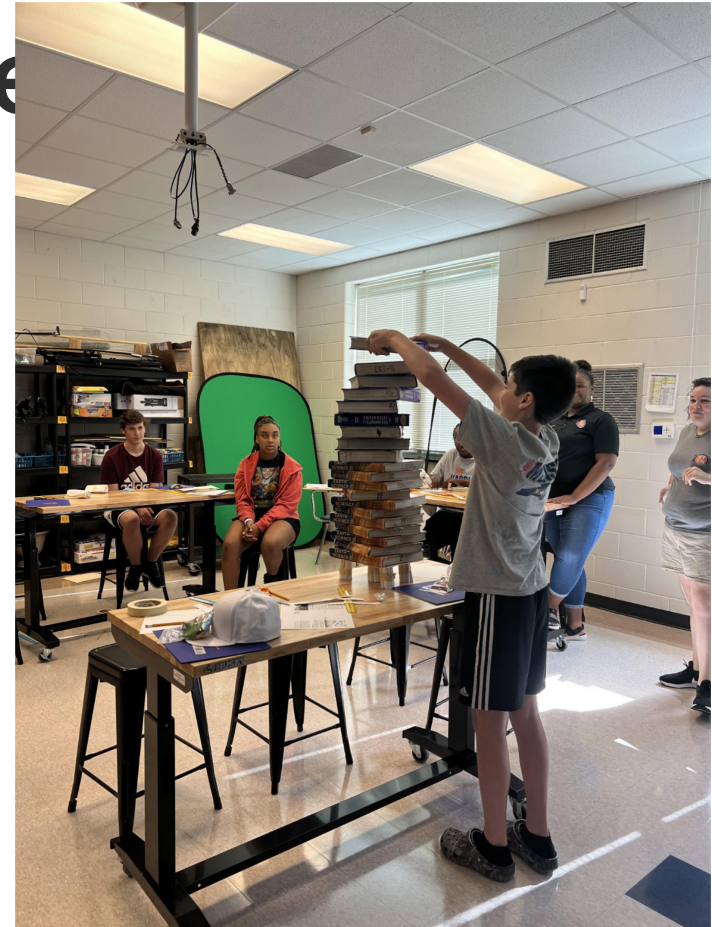

Magnet Program Overview



- ALL students will attend core classes that will focus on using the Engineering Design Process to complete hands-on projects and have exposure to career and college exploration. All students participate in quarterly schoolwide STEM Challenges.
- Students in grades 11 and 12 attend classes in their declared concentration area and receive recognition at graduation based on selected pathways.
- Students in grades 11 and 12 who are CTE Concentrators work with the STEM Coordinator to arrange internships and apprenticeships based on career interest and availability.
- All students will meet with the STEM Coordinator annually to develop career plans and review academic and post secondary goals.
- The Advisory Board includes stakeholders such as teachers, administrators, parents, students, and community partners.



Phases of the Implementation and current

Year 1 (2022 - 2023)

- Project-based learning will be implemented in ALL classrooms at LHS ✓
- Additional STEM-related professional development will be provided to ALL LHS staff ✓
- All LHS students will have opportunity to participate in 1 of 3 pathways: LHS College and Career Pathway, STEM Focused Program (VGCC) Pathway or Advanced Placement (AP) Diploma Pathway ✓
- District processes and procedures will be reviewed in support of the new magnet program (In progress.)
- District-wide magnet program marketing plan is developed (In progress.)

Year 2 (2023-2024)

- Through a magnet application process, students from across Franklin County will be considered for enrollment in Louisburg High School
- Full implementation of magnet program
